White Wine

- 1. La Tierra Rocosa Sauvignon Blanc. Chile** £17.50
Citrus notes on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. 175ml Glass £4.70
More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity. 250ml Glass £6.00
- 2. Malandrino Pinot Grigio. Italy** £17.50
The pale hue of the wine gives way to hints of perfume, pears, stone fruit and lime, as well as the occasional floral note. Fresh and vibrant acidity results in a light, easy drinking wine. 175ml Glass £4.70

- 3. Lonely Tree Chardonnay. USA** £17.50
A bright and vibrant style of Chardonnay, with a soft, tropical fruit character typical of Californian examples. Medium palate weight, with a pleasing mix of racy acidity and buttery softness. 175ml Glass £4.70

- 4. Picpoul Plo D'isabelle. Southern France** £19.95
Youthfully pale lemon yellow, with a nose of lemon and lime fruit, and an intriguing blend of white blossom and green herb notes. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish.
- 5. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand** £23.95
Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.
- 6. Montagny 1er Cru 'Les Millières'. Burgundy** £25.95
A delicious, fresh Chardonnay which has been fermented and matured in stainless steel tanks to preserve the pure peach, pear and acacia aromas. Soft and rich on the palate.

- 7. La Marca Prosecco 200ml Bottle. Italy** £7.50
A pale straw colour with a fine mousse and typical fruit characters of apples and pineapples. Your own mini bottle!
- 8. Cava Calamino NV. Spain** £19.50
Fresh and harmonious, displaying plenty of apple and toast flavours, yet intensely dry and mouth-watering.
- 9. Prosecco Corte Alta NV. Italy** £22.95
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.
- 10. House Champagne NV. France** £39.00

13. Vina Carrasco Merlot. Chile

Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. 175ml Glass £17.50

14. Five Foot Track Shiraz. Australia

A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles. 175ml Glass £17.50

15. Aires Andinos Malbec. Argentina

Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish. £18.95

16. Oltre Passo Primitivo Salento. Italy

Deep, dense ruby in colour, with a nose of warm prunes, dates and figs, with hints of sweet spice. Full and voluptuous, the mouth-feel is soft and plush, with toasty notes that linger on the finish. £21.95

17. Marques De Laia Rioja, Crianza. Spain

Red cherry colour of medium intensity with violet hues. Direct and fresh nose. Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. In mouth soft but with body and structure. £20.75

18. Luis Felipe Edwards Gran Reserva Merlot. Chile

Flavours of strawberry, cherry and blackberry, with notes of vanilla and green tobacco leaf. Soft tannins provide a great sense of volume. £23.25

19. Peter Lehmann Shiraz. Australia

Plenty of flesh and spice on the palate, with concentrated blackcurrant and bramble fruit as well as hints of mocha and dark chocolate. Full bodied and rich, a classic Aussie Shiraz. £24.95

20. Ch Caronne St Gemme, Haut- Médoc, Cru Bourgeois. Bordeaux

A bright nose of red fruit with a perfumed edge follows onto the palate with added nuances of smoke, black pepper and subtle oak. £29.95

Dessert Wine

21. Vistamar Late Harvest Moscatel. Chile

Straw yellow in colour, with golden highlights. Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricots and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavours. 100ml Glass £4.95
