3. L'Ord Du Sud Chardonnay, France.

Peaches & apricots. White flesh fruit & flowers. Clean, fresh finish. £5.40/£6.60/£19.75

4. Andersbrook Chenin Blanc, South Africa.

A fresh, dry Chenin with citrus aromas and soft, delicate orchard fruit on the palate well balanced by crisp acidity. £20.50

5. Vila Nova Vinho Verde, Portugal.

Vibrant, zingy & fresh Vinho Verde with the traditional spritz character. A refreshing wine with lively citrus flavours. £24.10

7. Muscadet Sèvre et Maine sur lie, France.

White stone and citrus fruit with a crisp finish which makes it ideal to accompany shellfish. £25.85

6. Makutu Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand.

Gooseberry & grassy aromas. A rich palate of tropical fruits. £26.25

Fruity, medium-bodied, plum & blackcurrant & a hint of spice. £5.00/£6.30/£18.85

12. Ancora Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Italy.

Notes of black pepper on the nose with flavours of forest fruits and spice. £5.20/£6.50/£19.40

13. Vista Sierra Malbec, Argentina.

Forest fruits, black plum with a hint of milk chocolate. £6.00/£7.60/£22.65

14. Andersbrook Shiraz, South Africa.

A rich, fruity, full bodied red with spicy aromas with blackcurrant and forest fruits. £20.50

15. Calusari Pinot Noir, Romania.

Medium bodied. Juicy plum & red cherry fruit, velvety finish. £21.20

16. Les Languedoc Syrah Grenache Carignan, France

Smooth, hints of wild herbs and forest fruits. Rich & gamey, earthy quality true to its origins in the Languedoc. £25.50

15. Miopasso Primitivo, Puglia, Italy.

Spicy & warming. Flavours of prunes & cherries and herby notes on the long finish. £26.00

16. Manzanos Rioja Tempranillo, Spain.

Modern style, enticing nose of juicy red fruits leading to a smooth, rich satisfying palate with just a hint of oak. £26.00

19. Cobos Felino Cabernet Sauvignon, Mendoza, Argentina.

Rich & full bodied, aged in oak barrels for 8 months, intense blackcurrant fruit, good acidity and smooth tannins. £37.00

Dessert Wine

21. Tabali Late Harvest Muscat, Chile (37.5cl)

Aromas of fresh papaya, honey and floral hints. Sweet & luscious, perfectly balanced by citrus acidity.
